He again went ahead with a birdie on the eleventh, but immediately gave it back with a bogey at the twelfth. A birdie on the fifteenth saw his lead now out to two with three to play. A bogey by Robinson on the sixteenth looked to have shut the door, but suddenly Spitty faulted. Now Robinson needed a birdie on the last hole for an unlikely play-off. While Spitty played his part with a bogey, Robinson's birdie putt missed.
